HOW TO APPLY CAR MAGNETS

Follow these three easy steps for the best results:

Step 1

For vehicle applications, be sure the surface is clean and well waxed.

Step 2

Be sure that both the surface where the magnetic vinyl is to be applied and the plain black magnetic side of the vinyl are free from moisture, dirt, dust and other foreign particles.

Step 3

Before applying, allow the magnetic to warm to room temperature. The temperature of the metal surface is not a factor. Allow one edge of the magnetic sheet to contact the metal surface. The rest of the sheet will then adhere itself to the surface as you allow it to make contact. If repositioning is required, remove the entire sheet of magnetic and reposition. Do not attempt to pull into place, as this could scratch the metal surface and stretch the magnetic.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

It is common for moisture to collect between the magnetic sheet and the vehicle surface. Remove the sheet at least once a week and dry both the magnetic and the vehicle surface.

Failure to periodically clean and reposition the magnetic sign could result in damage to both the sign and the vehicle surface. Over the years, as your paint on your vehicle ages, the area under the magnetic may not fade as quickly, leaving a darker color where the magnetic was placed.

IMPORTANT:

Magnetics must not be applied over decorative trim, body ridges, or curved areas. Also, additional layers of paint and/or body filler will reduce the ability of the magnetic material to stick to the vehicle.

Magnetics must be stored against a flat surface such as a filing cabinet, metal door, shelf or table. Make sure nothing is under or on top of the surface of the magnetic which would make an impression in the material. If the magnetic must be rolled, they should be rolled individually around a tube no less than 3" diameter with the white surface facing out, taped and stood on end. When handling and storing magnetic, remember that magnetism will destroy magnetic media such as cassettes and computer disks.
